# TILLES CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS PRESENTS CLASSICAL MYSTERY LIVE: A SYMPHONIC TRIBUTE TO THE BEATLES FEATURING FORMER BEATLEMANIA MEMBERS BACKED BY THE MASSAPEQUA PHILHARMONIC ON SEPTEMBER 21

# PERFORMANCE IS FOLLOWED BY APPEARANCE BY LEGENDARY BEATLES' PHOTOGRAPHER HARRY BENSON ON OCTOBER 10

Both Events Celebrate the Beatles' 60th Anniversary Tour of the U.S.

(Brookville, New York...September 2024)

Tilles Center for the Performing Arts at LIU Post announces Classical Mystery Tour: A Symphonic Tribute to the Beatles on Saturday, September 21 at 8 pm. The performance features original members of the Broadway sensation Beatlemania performing live with Long Island's own Massapequa Philharmonic, conducted by David Bernard. Hear timeless Beatles hits performed exactly as they were recorded including Yesterday, Eleanor Rigby, Hey Jude, A Hard Day's Night, All You Need is Love, and While My Guitar Gently Weeps, accompanied by the 30-piece orchestra.

Then, on Thursday, October 10 at 7 pm, is an appearance by **renowned Scottish photographer Harry Benson**, who was assigned to cover the Beatles' first trip to the U.S. in 1964. The evening will consist of a screening of the documentary, *Harry Benson: Shoot First*, which follows Harry's incredible career, followed by a Q&A with the legendary photographer, who will be onsite to answer audience questions.

Both events at Tilles Center mark the 60th Anniversary of the Beatles' final show of their historic U.S. tour, which took place at Forest Hills Stadium on September 20, 1964.

# **ABOUT CLASSICAL MYSTERY TOUR**

Since its initial show in 1996, Classical Mystery Tour has performed with more than 100 orchestras across the United States and around the world, receiving accolades from fans and the media. The *Los Angeles Times* called the show "more than just an incredible simulation...the swelling strings and soaring French horn lines gave the live performance a high goose-bump quotient...the crowd stood and bellowed for more."

"We really make an effort to sound exactly like the originals," explains James Owen, the founder of Classical Mystery Tour who also portrays John Lennon in the show. "The orchestra score is exact, right down to every note and instrument that was on the original recording. On 'Got to Get You into My Life,' we have two tenor saxes and three trumpets. That's what it was written for, and that's what we use. And on 'A Day in the Life,' that final big orchestra crescendo sounds amazing when it's played live."

The Massapequa Philharmonic Orchestra is Long Island's premier orchestra, bringing cultural leadership and exciting concerts featuring world-class soloists to Long Island's audiences for over 38 years. Most recently, the Massapequa Philharmonic has begun serving as Orchestra-in-Residence at Tilles Center, as well as the Nassau County Museum of Art, producing video concert events and chamber music alongside the exhibits at the Museum.

Harry first arrived in America with the Beatles in 1964. In his long and storied career, he has photographed twelve U.S. presidents, was just feet away from Senator Bobby Kennedy the night he was assassinated, was on the Meredith march with Martin Luther King, Jr., next to Coretta Scott King at her husband's funeral, and there when the Berlin Wall went up and when it came down.
