**TILLES JAZZ FEST RETURNS JULY 19, 2025 WITH
HEADLINERS ARTURO SANDOVAL AND JOHN PIZZARELLI BIG BAND**

*Second Annual Festival Presented in Collaboration with Jazz at Lincoln Center
Features Full Day of World-Class Jazz Across Four Stages*

(Brookville, New York... April 2025)

Following the resounding success of its inaugural year, **Tilles Center for the Performing Arts** is thrilled to announce the second annual **Tilles Jazz Fest**, presented in collaboration with **Jazz at Lincoln Center**, taking place **Saturday, July 19, 2025**. This all-day celebration of jazz will unfold across the scenic and historic **Long Island University Post** campus, with indoor and outdoor performances from 1 PM into the evening, culminating in headline performances by legendary trumpeter and ten-time Grammy winner **Arturo Sandoval** and acclaimed vocalist/guitarist **John Pizzarelli with his Big Band**. Tickets are on presale to Tilles Center members now, and go on sale to the public April 24.

The festival features nine concerts on four stages, including the Tilles Center Concert Hall, the Great Lawn and Rose Garden outdoor stages, and the historic Winnick House. Alongside Sandoval and Pizzarelli, the lineup includes percussionist and Yerba Buena founder **Pedrito Martínez and his Group**, dynamic brass ensemble **The Gotham Kings**, rising trumpet star **Summer Camargo Quintet**, vocalist and composer **Vanisha Gould**, outstanding student ensembles, and more to be announced.

"We are building a tradition that celebrates both the legacy and the future of jazz," said **Tom Dunn, Executive and Artistic Director** of Tilles Center. "From jazz legends like ten-time Grammy-award winner Arturo Sandoval to powerhouse veteran Pedrito Martínez, to the next generation of artists such as Summer Camargo, a member of the *Saturday Night Live* band, this year's festival brings together extraordinary talent for a joyful, community-wide celebration of music."

Gates open at noon, with the first performances beginning at 1 PM. Seating for daytime events is general admission, and attendees are encouraged to bring picnics, blankets, and lawn chairs. Family-friendly activities include an instrument petting zoo, food trucks, local artisan vendors, and a festive jazz second line parade to close the daytime events.

"Our continued collaboration with Tilles Center reflects a shared mission to celebrate jazz and bring it to audiences in new and meaningful ways," said **Georgina Javor, Vice President of Concerts and Touring** at Jazz at Lincoln Center. "Tilles Jazz Fest offers the perfect summer setting for incredible music, discovery, and community."
